## \* Why did you choose our University or Hospital?\* How did you find our university of Hospital?

I am a 6th year medical student from Germany and spent 12 weeks at Nara Medical University. On a German medical website, this hospital was listed as one of the 6 hospitals which were eligible for an international clerkship in Japan so I applied for an elective from 30th of Dec 2019 to the 20th of March 2020.
